- The class is limited to 15 students.

**Please note: This is a rigorous, demanding program. Students must register for a minimum of 25 lessons per week and be at a GV 4 level of English. Those students who are not at GV 4 level at time of arrival may be placed in General English in lieu of Academic Preparation.**
