Strengthen your academic language skills.

English for Academic Purposes (EAP) is a popular program with over 20% of our students taking this class. Students are required to enroll in this program to fulfill their GV Pathway to a university or college without an official IELTS or TOEFL score.

The EAP focuses on strengthening general language skills, especially in speaking fluency and communication in the morning session, followed by academic reading and writing skills in the afternoon classes. The program also covers essay and term paper writing, study and research skills, note-taking, and presentations.

As part of the program, students are able to meet regularly with the Academic Counselor to review progress on their pathway to university/college, including English level, academic qualifications, application/documentation and communication with the university/college to ensure a successful transfer.

Entrance Level: Minimum GV 5
